

Day Hike Shivapuri National Park

Trip features

Trip duration: 8 hours / Hiking Time: 5 / 6 hours.

Tour Description:

In the morning you will be picked-up at your hotel by our driver and guide. We drive for about 20 minutes till we reach the Budhanikantha Temple which is 8 kilometres north of Kathmandu. This temple is famous for the pond with a large statue of the reclining Vishnu. From Budhanilkantha uphill till the gates of the Shivapuri National Park. This is an unique government protected forest where over 500 species of animals are found. We start our hike from the southern boundary of the area where the army check post is located. Nagi

Gumpa situated at an altitude of 2330 m north of Kathmandu and above Budhanilkantha Temple is only Monastery for the Nuns practice Buddhism and foreigners often come there for meditation. It is a steep uphill hike through narrow and dusty trail and gradual uphill trial to Shivapuri. After lunch and strolling around from sometime, we take a short cut down hill trail to Kopan for about two hours and drive back to Kathmandu.

Shivapuri situated at an altitude of 2563m north of Kathmandu is second highest hill around Kathmandu valley. Baghdwar, Shivapuri locates near source of holy river Bagmati
